

Speaking Before Council

Hilliard City Council welcomes and encourages members of the public to express their opinions about legislation on Council's agenda. To provide for an orderly meeting and to ensure that adequate time is permitted for members of the public to address Council, members of public are asked to follow these rules:

- Any individual desiring to address Council should complete the appropriate speaker's sign-in sheet located at the table outside Council Chambers.
- Once you have signed in, please take a seat in the Council Chambers. The Council President or a Council Member will call upon you when it is your time to address Council.
- To ensure that you are heard, please speak from the podium and into the microphone. First state your name and address and then begin speaking about the legislation you identified on the speaker's sign-in sheet.
- In order to ensure that each speaker has an opportunity to address Council, each speaker will be limited to three minutes.
- Council requests that all speakers be respectful of each other. Your subject will not contain obscenity, commercial advertising, defamation of character, slander, nor shall a speaker be permitted to conduct his or herself in a disruptive manner.
